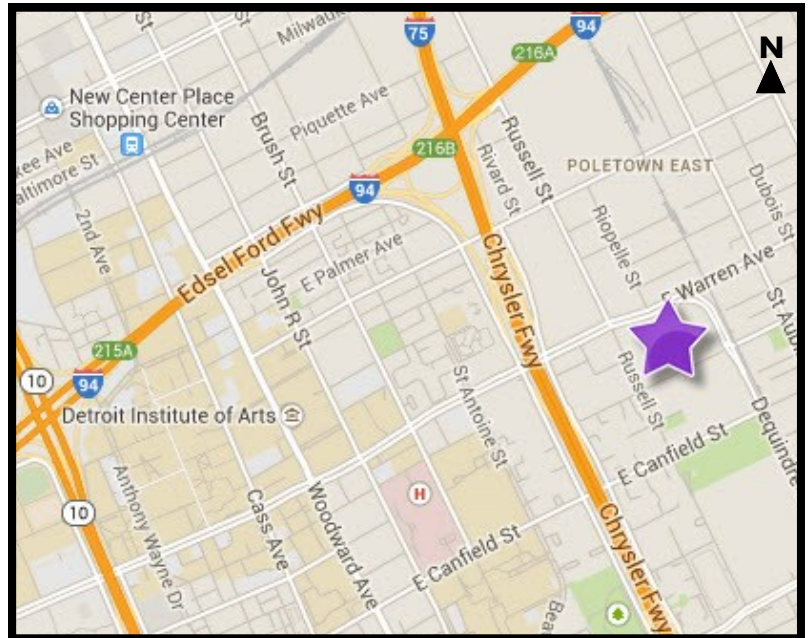
GETTING TO THE BANK:

From the North: Take I-75 south to Warren Ave exit 53A then make a left on Warren. The bank will be on the right

From the South: Take I-75 north to Warren Ave exit 53A then make a right on Warren. The bank will be on the right.

From the West: Take I-94 east to Russell Street exit 216B then make a right on Russell and a left on Warren, the bank will be on the right

From the East: Take I-94 west to Woodward Ave. exit 215C. Make a left onto the Edsel Ford Service Drive then a left onto Warren Ave. The bank will be on the right

ENTERING THE BUILDING:

- Once a guest arrives at the gates on Warren Ave., they should press the red button and notify the officer of their name and who they are here to see/the event name.
- Once the light turns green, they will proceed into the parking lot and once parked, they can enter through the main doors of the building.
- Similar to an airport, guests will walk through a metal detector, and all personal items such as briefcases, bags, cell phones, metal objects from pockets, etc. will be scanned through an x-ray machine. Trays are available for small items and an alternative scanning device is available upon request.
- A Bank representative will need to verify all guests' identification using government issued photo ID (passport, state ID card, driver's license, etc.).

POLICIES:

- No outside food is permitted on federal reserve property
- A bank employee must check in all guests before they can proceed past the lobby
- No weapons of any kind will be permitted (guns, knives, mace/pepper spray, etc.)
