Michigan Depends on World Markets


 Exports from Michigan helped contribute to the \$2.33 trillion of U.S. goods and services exports in 2017.

Michigan's Top 5 Export Categories (Millions of U.S. Dollars)




Exports Support Jobs

 Nationally, U.S. jobs supported by exports reached an estimated 10.7 million in 2016, up 1.2 million from 2006.

Exports Sustain Thousands of Michigan Businesses



...and **24%** of known Michigan goods export value







Number of Employees by Country of UBO






Free Trade Agreements

- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.
- Michigan's exports to U.S. FTA partners totaled \$40.7 billion in 2017.

In 2017, exports to FTA markets accounted for 68% of Michigan exports



Since 2007, exports from Michigan to FTA markets have grown by 24%



Michigan's Metropolitan **Exports**

Detroit-Warren-Dearborn is the 6th largest metro area reporting exports nationwide.
